1. Does this feature align with our product vision?

2. What problem does this feature solve?

Task: Identify the customer pain point this feature addresses. Write down the problem and explain why solving it matters to your users and business.

3. Who is this feature for?

Task: Define the target user or customer segment for this feature. Write down their persona and how this feature will impact their experience.

4. How will this feature add value to our users?

Task: Describe the benefit users will gain. Is it saving time, reducing effort, or improving outcomes? Write down the specific value in one sentence.

5. Does this feature have measurable success criteria?

Task: Write down 2-3 metrics you'll use to measure the success of this feature (e.g., adoption rate, user retention, increased engagement).

6. What are the potential risks of implementing this feature?

Task: Brainstorm 3 potential risks, such as overcomplicating the product, technical challenges, or misalignment with user needs. Write down one mitigation strategy for each risk.

7. How does this feature impact our existing product?
